



Spring Update 2026

The year-on-year bulb planting delivered a lovely display from late January onwards.



After discussions with OneTrafford the hedges were cut before the nesting season started and we're pleased to see the colony of sparrows, in the hedge near the Link Road gate, is thriving.

We've met with staff from OneTrafford about the need for repairs to the path from the car park to the playground; nothing has been done, as yet, although we've been told it will be repaired. A large amount of woodchip has been laid over a stretch of the path that runs outside of the fence. This is a very wet, muddy area that becomes virtually impassable in winter so we're glad something has been done.

The Friends volunteers have been working on the area behind the pavilion and the car park keeping them weed-free and tidy. We have also picked up a lot of litter!

The golf opened in early April and has been well used thanks to the fine, dry weather. We asked for the greens and bunkers to be improved and we are now waiting for fresh sand to be delivered.

The 5-a-side football pitch is very worn so one of the Friends Group could be seen with a metal detector trying to locate the other set of goal post fittings! No luck yet but he's not given up.
